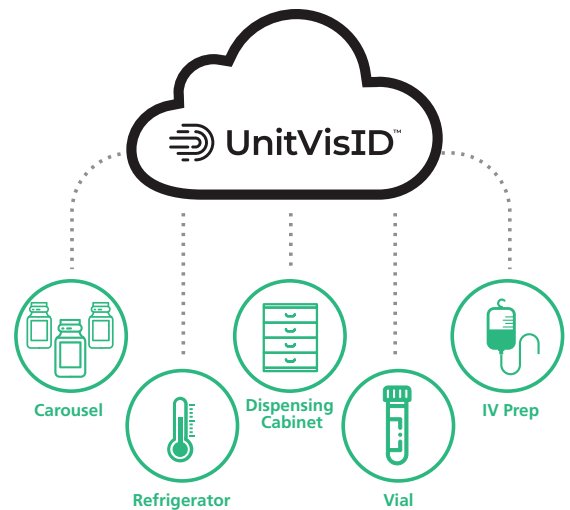


Benefits to Automating Manual Workflow
